Medicaid Ride Information:

To be eligible for Medicaid rides, you must:

- be eligible for Medicaid
- have a scheduled appointment with a Medicaid provider
- make sure you have not other reasonable way to make it to your appointment

How to schedule Medicaid Ride appointments:

1. Call your area public transportation provider, if possible, at least 2 days in advance. See below for providers.
2. Have your Medicaid ID Number ready
3. Have your doctor's name, appointment time and date to give to transportation provider
4. Transportation providers will verify that you and your doctor are medicaid eligible and schedule your trip.

Please note: It is important you notify Medicaid that you are experiencing homelessness and to provide the specific motel/hotel you are sheltered in. This will allow Medicaid to connect you with the proper transportation provider. Make sure to notify Medicaid and schedule your ride at least 2 days prior to your appointment. If you move into long term housing, notify Medicaid of your new housing situation.
